

## THE OTHER VICTIMS

Other victims of violence against women are their children.

They also suffer such violence, with important consequences in many cases.

Almost all of them have low self-esteem, insecurity, fear, difficulties to interact with the opposite sex, ambivalence of feelings...

It's difficult to speak in general about the consequences of domestic violence in psychological development and school integration of children.

The reason is that there are a lot of variables whose influence can affect those consequences.

Among these variables would be the following:

The type of violence suffered: physical, emotional, direct, indirect, etc, the age of the child exposed to situations of domestic violence, the relationship of the aggressor with the victim and the possibility of receiving specialized assistance.

All these variables and some others derived from them may make the consequences more or less serious.
